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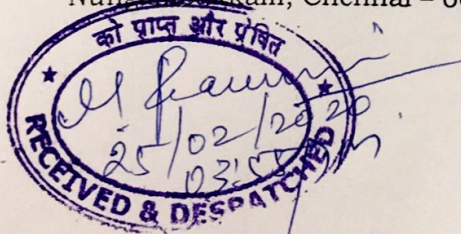
Please refer to your RTI application dated 24.01.2020 filed under RTI Act, 2005 and received in this office on 12.02.2020.


