MEMORANDUM

This office is in receipt of letter from All India Central Excise Inspectors' Association, Chennai Branch dated 23.03.2022 giving notice for Participation in Confederation Program on 28.03.2022 & 29.03.2022. However, in this connection, it is informed that holding of meetings/ demonstrations by Govt. servants without permission within office premises is in **violation in Rule 7(4) of the CCS(Conduct) Rules, 1964**. The right to form an Association does not include any guaranteed right to strike. Going on strike is a grave misconduct under the Conduct Rules and that misconduct by the Government employees is required to be dealt with in accordance with the law. Any employee going on strike in any form will be taken serious note of and those concerned would face the consequence which, besides deduction of wages, may also include appropriate disciplinary action.

- 02. As such, action in instances of violation of discipline and conduct rules would be taken in accordance with the instructions on the subject.
- 03. This is issued with the approval of the Competent Authority, Cadre Control, Tamil Nadu and Puducherry.
